REFERENCE MANAGERS

The best tools to manage your sources and reference them

ENDNOTE

<u>EndNote</u> is an extensive application for collecting, managing and using scholarly articles and making source references and bibliographies. Use it online or with the desktop and iPad applications.





REFWORKS

<u>RefWorks</u> is slightly simpler than EndNote and works entirely in the cloud. You can store and organize sources in it and automatically create citations and bibliographies.

MENDELEY

With <u>Mendeley</u>, a free tool from Elsevier, you can manage and share your sources and create lists of source references. Also available online, as a desktop application or with a mobile app.



ZOTERO



<u>Zotero</u> is a non-profit, open source alternative to Mendeley. With the Save to Zotero browser plugin you can store a pdf of web page quickly and easily.

SCRIBBR

With <u>Scribbr</u> you can create your bibliography online according to the APA style in no time. The APA-generator is 100% free. Do check the rules of your study program.





WORD

<u>MS Word</u> also allows you to add source information to create citations and bibliographies, but you can't manage them like you can with the specialized applications above.

CITE WHILE YOU WRITE

Most reference managers have a plugin for MS Word. This allows you to make citations from your source collection while writing. And when you're finished you can create your bibliography in the right citation style with one click of a



GROUP WORK

Another advantage of using a reference manager is being able to share your source collection with others. In that way you can manage, use and comment your sources for group assignments. Handy!
